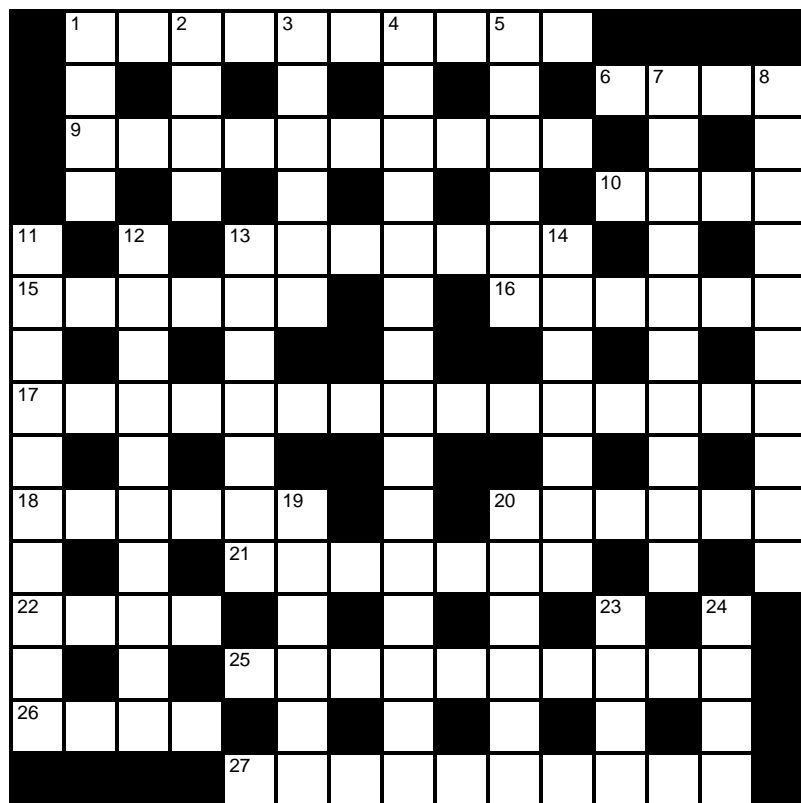


Cryptic Crossword No. 108
